





- Postdoctoral fellowships: 80% 100% of the awards have been allocated to foreign candidates. Five per annum.
- Doctoral scholarship: 4 out of the 6 awards were allocated to foreign nationals from the partner countries
- Masters: 4 out of 12 awards were allocated to foreign nationals from the partner countries
- Undergraduate: 4 Botswana students at UKZN per year as per SA/Botswana bilateral agreement. 4 from the partner countries doing a technical degree at DUT.

Partner countries are: Botswana, Ghana, Kenya, Madagascar, Mauritus, Mozambique, Namibia, Zambia
